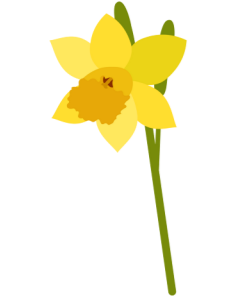
Andy has enjoyed learning some new skills. He has been cutting and drilling copper pipes to make beautiful windchimes.
